World Gourmet Summit (WGS) Awards Of Excellence 2011

Public Nominations for Singapore & Regional WGS Awards Of Excellence Open On 23 August 2010

An Opportunity to Recognise Chefs, Sommeliers and F&B Establishments

Singapore, **04 August 2010**: The World Gourmet Summit (WGS) Awards of Excellence 2011 invites the public to nominate their favourite chefs, sommeliers and F&B establishments for various high profile Singapore and regional awards.

Held annually in conjunction with the World Gourmet Summit, the WGS Awards Of Excellence is the only Singapore national awards programme that acknowledges the efforts of key players in the food and beverage (F&B) industry who deliver the best dining experience for their guests.

Organised by Peter Knipp Holdings (PKH) Pte Ltd and supported by Singapore Tourism Board (STB), the awards aim to recognise and motivate talents to excel in professions related to the F&B industry and to promote an appreciation of dining in Singapore and throughout the Asia region.

"The general public plays a vital role in determining the winners of these important culinary awards," says Peter A Knipp, chief executive officer of PKH, "consumers are increasingly wining and dining at quality establishments and are entitled to an avenue for their voices to be heard. The WGS Awards Of Excellence is the F&B industry equivalent of the Oscars, so if someone has had an amazing experience at a particular restaurant, or feels that a particular chef is deserving of recognition for their outstanding culinary skills, then we want to hear from them".

To ensure that results best represent the industry's finest; the awards selections undergo an incredibly detailed and thorough evaluation process. The initial round of nominations, which are open to the public, also includes nominations from 250 industry jurors. The nominations are tabulated with the highest scoring nominees for each award category proceeding to round two. At this level, the public, together with 150 industry jurors for the Singapore awards, and 50 for the regional awards cast their votes. The votes are tabulated with the top three to five highest scoring nominees for each award category proceeding to the third round (finalists), subjected to a final evaluation by the appointed industry jurors.

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A total of 27 awards in the culinary, hotel, industry, restaurant and culinary institution categories will be presented, along with eight others by the Singapore Workforce Skills Qualification (WSQ), and eight scholarships at the 2011 instalment. Of these, 12 awards from the Singapore category and three awards from the regional category will be open to the public for nominations.

The public nomination for the Singapore awards opens on 23 August 2010 and closes on 15 October 2010.



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Regional Category

The WGS Awards Of Excellence reaches beyond the shores of Singapore to recognise deserving regional individuals from Hong Kong, Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, Macau and Vietnam - acknowledging their dedication and talent in the food and beverage (F&B) industry.

For the regional awards, three awards will be open for nominations, while the remaining award will be judged by jury members comprising industry peers and established media personalities.

The three regional awards open for public nominations are:

- Manitowoc Restaurateur of the Year
- Asian Cuisine Chef of the Year
- Vismark Asian Restaurant of the Year

The remaining award is Electrolux Culinary Institution of the Year.

The first round of nominations for the regional awards opens on 23 August 2010 and closes on 12 November 2010.
